



Quintuple, Quadruple and Triple Crown Winners

Definitions of “Crown” and “Category” Winners

- A "**Quintuple Crown**" winner must have won at least one USA National or World championship on a USA team in 5 of the 5 levels (youth, college, club, masters and grand masters).
- A "**Quadruple Crown**" winner must have won at least one USA National or World championship on a USA team in 4 of the 5 levels (youth, college, club, masters and grandmasters).
- A "**Triple Crown**" winner must have won at least one USA National or World championship on a USA team in 3 of the 5 levels (youth, college, club, masters and grand masters).

Qualifying Titles:

1. USA HS Open/Girls 1988, 1998-2004 or USA YC Open/Girls/Mixed or WJUC Junior Boys/Girls
 2. USA College Open/Women's
 3. USA Club Open/Women's/Mixed or WFDF (WUGC/WUCC) Open/Women's/Mixed or IWGA World Games Mixed
 4. USA Club Masters Open/Women's or WFDF (WUGC or WUCC) Masters
 5. USA Club Grand Masters
- A "**Quintuple Category**" winner must have won a USA National or World championship on a USA team in 5 of the 12 different categories.
 - A "**Quadruple Category**" winner must have won a USA National or World championship on a USA team in 4 of the 12 different categories.
 - A "**Triple Category**" winner must have won a USA National or World championship on a USA team in 3 of the 12 different categories. *(Although Triple Crown winners are automatically Triple Category winners, they are only listed in the Triple Crown winner section.)*
